Her entire countenance was noticeably different, as she walked along with a huge smile on her face. She said she didn't know why, but she felt so different inside. We explained to her that God's Spirit was working inside her, and this is why she felt so different. Marissa literally glowed that night, and she hasn't stopped glowing since. Every time we see her she has a big smile on her face, because of the hope she now has in her heart!

Daniél Bogard Memorial Walk For Haiti
