### Haiti Mission Digging a Well ~ A Major Endeavor

One would think that digging a well on Aslan's property in Haiti would be a relatively easy undertaking. Quite the contrary, it is a major event!

Pictured right is our shallow well at about 25 feet. One man worked over 2 weeks with a straight pick, a small shovel and a bucket before he finally struck water at 45

feet (four and one-half stories deep)! He did have a helper, who pulled up buckets of dirt and rocks ~ and pulled him up at the



end of the day as well. We now have a small building around the well, and before long our dreams for the property will begin to take shape.

John and Leneita and their three children have moved to Roanoke, Virginia, where they are working with Acts 2 Ministry, another inner-city work.

To say that we will miss this wonderful couple is a real understatement. What a gift they have been to us!
